

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PREFACE.

These tables have been compiled with a view to facilitate the study of strategical questions in Central Asia.

Section I consists of routes from India through Afghanistan towards the Russo-Afghan frontier, and Section II, of routes from various points on the Trans-Caspian railway towards the same frontier.

As regards arrangement, in Section I, the three routes (i) from Peshawar to Herat, (ii) from Bannu to Ghazni, and (iii) from Chaman to Kandahar, have been taken as trunk lines. These are followed, until the point of departure of some important route leading frontier-wards is reached. This is traced in all its branches. A return is then made to the trunk line, and the same process repeated.

In Section II the routes lead southwards, but otherwise the arrangement is identical.

The spelling of names given in the Map of Afghanistan (1" = 24 miles; 1891) has been adhered to, but any other spelling in common use has been added in brackets.
